Daily clues will be posted at 8:00 AM starting Monday, July 27 until Saturday, August 1, 2015 unless the medallion is found.



\$250 prize with qualifying button pre-registration;
\$125 prize without qualifying button pre-registration.

Registration cards (which accompany button purchase) must be submitted/postmarked before Friday, July 24, 2015 to be eligible for the \$250 grand prize. Medallion searchers must purchase a \$3 Canadian Days button as a button is required to claim the prize. *Proceeds from the button sales help to support the cost of the all-volunteer community festival.* Buttons sold at local businesses. A list of locations can be found on our website under FAQ.

Registration cards can be dropped off at City Center or mailed to PO Box 13642, Saint Paul, MN 55113-0642. Prize awarded on Sunday, August 2 at 4:30 PM in Spooner Park. Must be present.

CONTEST DETAILS AND RULES

1. The Canadian Days Medallion will be found on Little Canada public land.
2. No digging will be necessary. The use of shovels or other digging tools is NOT permitted.
3. No climbing will be necessary.
4. No disassembly will be required to find the medallion including irrigation heads, light fixtures and other equipment.
5. Searchers must not damage public property or otherwise violate laws or ordinances. For example, city parks open daily at ½ hour before sunrise and close ½ hour after sunset.
6. City of Little Canada employees, Canadian Days Committee members, US Bank employees, or family members of said employees or members, are NOT eligible to win. Family members are defined as parents, children or siblings.
7. Discovery of the medallion must be reported immediately by calling 651-492-4680.
8. Searchers assume all risk for personal injury.
9. Taxes due are the responsibility of the winner.
10. The winner will be required to recite the clue that led him/her to the medallion and may be asked to sign a photo release form for publicity and promotional purposes.
11. If the medallion is not found by 9:00 PM August 1, the hunt will terminate and the prize money will carry forward to next year.
12. The decisions of the Canadian Days Committee are final.
