

Hiway Federal Credit Union Hunt for the Gold Puck

“Second Drop” Official Contest Rules

NO PURCHASE, PAYMENT OR DONATION OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS CONTEST. A PURCHASE, PAYMENT OR DONATION WILL NOT INCREASE OR IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

1. ELIGIBILITY. The Hiway Federal Credit Union® (Hiway) “Hiway Hunt for the Gold Puck” “Second Drop” Contest (the “Contest”) is open only to entrants who, as of the entry date, are 18 years of age or older and are permanent legal residents of Minnesota or Wisconsin. The Contest is void outside Minnesota or Wisconsin and where prohibited or restricted by law. Employees, officers and directors of Minnesota Wild Hockey Club, L.P. (“Wild”), Hiway Federal Credit Union (“Sponsor”) (Wild and Sponsor collectively the “Contest Entities”), their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, divisions, advertising and promotion agencies, and the immediate families (defined as parents, spouses, children, siblings, grandparents, and their respective spouses) or members of the same household (whether related or not) of each such employee, officer and director, are not eligible to enter. Previous contest winners are ineligible to enter for three (3) years from the date of their most recent win. The Contest, and any website pages and advertisements relating thereto, is intended for viewing only within the eligible Contest territory, and entrants must be present in the eligible Contest territory at the time they enter.

2. TIMING. The Contest begins at 8:00 am Central Time (“CT”) on Friday, March 3, 2017, and ends at 11:59 p.m. CT on Friday, March 31, 2017 (“Contest Period”). Wild’s computer is the official timekeeping device for the Contest.

Wild and Sponsor reserves the right to alter, suspend, modify or terminate the Contest, the Contest Period and/or the Entry Period in its sole discretion and without notice for any reason.

3. HOW TO ENTER. There is one (1) way to enter the Contest: Participants are eligible to win a prize by finding a “winning hockey puck” hidden on public land in Ramsey, Hennepin or Dakota County. The winning hockey puck will be placed by March 2, 2017 at one location. The winning hockey puck will not be placed on private property or areas including any city, state or federal building, the State Capitol, the Como Park Conservatory or on a public golf course. Digging or damaging property is not permitted, nor required in order to locate the winning puck. During the Contest Period, clues will be delivered via Sponsor’s Twitter and Facebook accounts and website on a weekly basis describing a location in Ramsey, Hennepin or Dakota County, Minnesota where participants may find the winning hockey puck. One (1) clue will be provided each week. Participants must follow the Sponsor’s Twitter account or visit the Sponsor’s website for the duration of the Contest Period to be eligible for potential prizes.

- a. During the Entry Period, go to the www.wild.com/hiwaygoldpuck page to find the Official Rules and Contest description. By actively participating in the Contest, participants agree to the Official Rules.
- b. LIMIT: All entrants are subject to verification prior to the awarding of a prize, as are the eligibility, age and other claims of information provided by a potential prize winner. See Section 12 below (“Data Collection”) regarding data collected in connection with an entrant’s ability to opt-out of /opt-in to receiving marketing and promotional materials. All participants must fill out a release form if they locate the gold hockey puck and are determined a winner at the sole discretion of Contest Entities.

4. AGREEMENT TO OFFICIAL RULES AND DECISIONS. By participating in the Contest, each entrant fully and unconditionally agrees to be bound by and accepts these Official Rules and the decisions of the Contest Entities (including, without limitation, decisions regarding eligibility of entries, the selection of entrants and the winners, and the awarding of prizes), which are final and binding in all respects.

5. SELECTION; ODDS; NOTIFICATION

For those who have entered in accordance with Section 3 above, winner will include the entrant who located the winning hockey puck.

Odds of winning will be based on the number of individuals searching for the hockey puck. By participating, entrants agree to abide by and be bound by these Official Contest Rules.

If no one claims the winning hockey puck during the Contest Period, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, Sponsor may elect to donate the Prize to a charity of their choosing.

Sponsor reserves the right to determine the winner based on whichever criteria it chooses.

6. CLAIMING THE "WINNING HOCKEY PUCK":

To claim your winning hockey puck for the winner selected in Section 5 above, you must be eligible and you **MUST** call the number listed on the back of the puck when you find the winning hockey puck on the day it has been found. Sponsor will ask for the verification code on the back of the puck to determine if you are the Official winner of the Contest.

Winners will be required to sign and return (if necessary) an Affidavit of Eligibility, Release of Liability and a Publicity Release (where legal) and send a W-9 to Sponsor within fourteen (14) days of request. Non-compliance with these requirements will result in disqualification and the prize will be forfeited. In the event that a prize or prize notification is returned as undeliverable, such prize will be forfeited. Failure to return a W-9 or a completed and signed Affidavit of Eligibility, Release of Liability and Publicity Release within the allotted time period will result in disqualification of the winner and forfeiture of the prize.

7. PARTICIPATION CONDUCT: A participant may be removed from a Location and/or disqualified from participating in the Contest, at the sole discretion of Sponsor and its affiliates, for any reason at any time. Any act performed by participant defined by Federal, State or Local statute or ordinance as constituting a criminal act may result in removal from the Location and/or disqualification from Contest. At the sole discretion of Sponsor, if a participant uses profanity, or demonstrates any lewd or sexually suggestive gestures or full or partial nudity, Sponsor shall have the right to remove the individual from the Location and/or disqualify participant from Contest. At the sole discretion of Sponsor, if a participant creates a potential for death, disability, injury, property damage or any other negative incident during Contest or during his/her participation in Contest, Sponsor shall have the right to disqualify participant from Contest and to remove that individual from the Location. And disqualification and/or removal from the Location will result in forfeiture of any prize that may have been awarded.

By participating, each participant (i) understands that Sponsor has not arranged for and does not carry any insurance of any kind for participant's benefit and that participant will be solely responsible for obtaining and paying for any medical, life, accident, automobile, property or other insurance relative to his/her participation in Contest; (ii) agrees that he/she will obey all traffic, safety and other applicable laws and will not speed or otherwise expose himself/herself or any other individual, whether participating in the Contest or not, to harm or danger of any kind; (iii) agrees to release and hold harmless Sponsor and its affiliates from any injuries, losses or damages of any kind, including, without limitation, death, to persons, or property resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from participating in the Contest; and (iv) agrees to indemnify Sponsor and its affiliates from any losses, liabilities or expenses, including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees, resulting from any claims, proceedings or investigations arising from or in connection with participant's participation in Contest or compliance or non-compliance with these Official Contest Rules.

8. PRIZE. Subject to the terms and conditions of these Official Rules, one (1) winner will receive a prize of \$1,000. The prize will come in the form of a check made out to the winner. Any costs not specifically noted above in this Section 8 will be the sole responsibility of the prize winner and/or winner's guest, including but not limited to, any costs associated with travel in connection with the prize to and from the Xcel Energy Center, parking, gratuities, food and beverage costs.

All prizes must be accepted as awarded, and prize is awarded "AS IS" with no warranty, representation, or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or in law, made by Contest Entities or for which Contest Entities shall be liable, including, without limitation, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, NON-INFRINGEMENT OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. No substitution, assignment, refund or transfer of a prize is permitted, except by Wild, who reserves the right to substitute a prize (or a component thereof) with another prize (or component thereof) of greater or equal value, including cash, if a prize is not available for any reason as determined by Wild in its sole discretion. Winner is solely responsible for any and all costs, fees, taxes and expenses associated with prize award, receipt and use, including, without limitation, all federal, state and local taxes on the prize and any travel costs that may be incurred. **Winners receiving \$600 or more of total prizes during the Contest are required to be issued an IRS Form 1099 for the value of the prizes received.**

9. PUBLICITY. Except where prohibited by law, participation in the Contest constitutes entrant's consent to Wild's and Sponsor's (and their respective designees', successors' and assigns') use of entrant's name, biography, likeness, voice, photographs, video, opinions, statements, hometown, state and country for promotional purposes in any manner or media (including, without limitation, online), worldwide, in perpetuity, and without further payment, consideration, notice, review or consent.

10. GENERAL CONDITIONS. Contest Entities reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to terminate, modify or suspend the Contest if, in their opinion, there is any suspected or actual evidence of electronic or non-electronic tampering with any portion of the Contest, or if viruses, bugs, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical difficulties or failures or any other factor beyond Contest Entities' reasonable control corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Contest. In such event, Contest Entities reserve the right (but do not have the obligation) in their sole discretion to award prizes at random from among eligible, non-suspect entries received up to the time of suspected impairment. Contest Entities reserve the right in their sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to deliberately damage any website or undermine the legitimate operation of this Contest is a violation of criminal and civil laws, and, should such an attempt be made, Contest Entities reserve the right to seek damages and other remedies from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. Contest Entities' failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision or any other provision of these Official Rules.

11. RELEASE. By entering, each entrant forever and irrevocably releases and holds harmless Contest Entities, their respective parents, subsidiaries and affiliates, and their respective agents, advertising and promotion agencies, Contest partners and prize suppliers, and all of their respective employees, officers, directors, shareholders and agents from and against all claims, damages or liabilities arising in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from entrant's participation and/or entry in the Contest and/or entrant's award, receipt or use of any prize awarded in the Contest.

12. LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY. Contest Entities are not responsible for: (a) incorrect or inaccurate transcription of entry information or late, lost, stolen, unintelligible, illegible, damaged, mutilated, altered, incomplete, misdirected or postage due entries or entries received through impermissible or illegitimate channels, all of which will be disqualified; (b) technical failures of any kind, including but not limited to the malfunctioning of any telephone, computer online systems, computer equipment, website, server provider, network, hardware or software; (c) the unavailability or inaccessibility of any website or service; (d) unauthorized intervention in any part of the entry process or the Contest; (e) printing, typographical, electronic or human errors which may occur in the offer or administration of the Contest or the processing of entries; or (f) any injury or damage to persons or property, including but not limited to entrant's computer, which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from entrant's participation in the Contest, or from viewing, playing or downloading any material from the Wild's website(s), regardless of whether the material was prepared by the Wild or a third party, and regardless of whether the material is connected to the Wild's respective websites by a hypertext link.

13. DISPUTES. Entrant agrees that: (a) any and all disputes, claims, and causes of action arising out of or connected with this Contest, or any prizes awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and solely and exclusively in a federal or state court located in Minneapolis or St. Paul, Minnesota; entrant submits to sole

and exclusive personal jurisdiction to said courts in the State of Minnesota for any such dispute and irrevocably waives any and all rights to object to such jurisdiction; (b) any and all claims, judgments, and awards shall be limited to actual out of pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering this Contest but in no event attorneys' fees; and (c) under no circumstances will entrant be permitted to obtain awards for and entrant hereby waives all rights to claim punitive, incidental and consequential damages and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased. SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE LIMITATION OR EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, SO THE ABOVE MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of entrant or Sponsor in connection with the Contest shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Minnesota, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules of provisions (whether of the State of Minnesota, the United States, or any other jurisdiction), which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of Minnesota.
