

The 2018 Midwest Communications Winterfest Medallion Hunt

Some things you should know:

- The 2018 Winterfest Medallion is made of clear acrylic and is three and one quarter inches in diameter. It has unique markings and cannot be duplicated. Any forgeries will be easily identifiable. Furthermore, when the medallion is submitted, we will ask you specifically where it was found
 - The 2017 Winterfest Medallion Hunt did not occur
 - The Winterfest 2016 medallion was hidden in Duluth's Norton Park just off the DWP Trail
 - The Winterfest 2015 medallion was hidden off the Millennium Trail in Superior's Municipal Forest
- The 2014 medallion was hidden in Amity Park on a trail about 75 yards off the Seven Bridges Road in Duluth
 - The 2013 Winterfest Medallion was hidden in Hermantown's Keene Creek Park near the creek.
 - The 2012 medallion was discovered in Hartley Park off one of the many trails there
- The Winterfest 2011 medallion was hidden at Billings Park in Superior near the public boat landing
 - 2010 medallion was hidden at Enger Park in Duluth near the Peace Bell
 - The 2009 medallion was hidden at Lief Erikson Park
- The winner of the medallion hunt must be at least 18 years of age or older. However, anyone under the age of 18 may search as long as an adult claims the prize and assumes responsibility for any taxes associated with winning
- The medallion is hidden outdoors on *public property* somewhere in Duluth, MN; Superior, WI; Proctor, MN; or Hermantown, MN. No trespassing on private property will be at all necessary
- It will be hidden *above* ground. However, it is possible the medallion will be buried by snow or loose debris like sticks or leaves.
 - No climbing or scaling will be required
- It will not be necessary to bend or destroy vegetation to find the medallion.
 - The medallion is *not* hidden within 10 feet of any body of water.
- If property is being damaged, we reserve the right to cancel the contest entirely.
