Come on out and bring their glove.

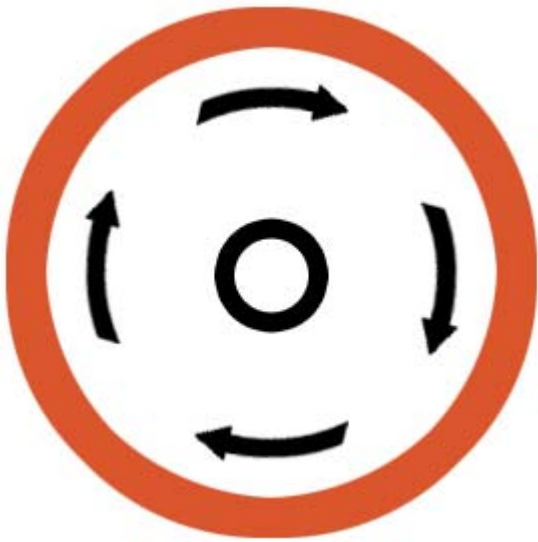
Classes are still open, so you've got the **advantage (tennis term)** if you register today.
